### Group Exhibition

*Square Art Projects* is pleased to announce its first pop-up exhibition after relocating to London, showcasing work from six international artists working in photography, painting and sculpture.

The artists on show are: *Katherine Di Turi, Cipriano Martínez, Lucia Pizzani, Piers Veness, Augusto Villalba and Simon Zabell.*

The exhibition will highlight the connections between the artists and their practices. Although these artists are from different countries and backgrounds, they are linked through their training in London: three of them studied at the Slade, and three of them studied at Chelsea.

The photographs of *Katherine Di Turi* are centered upon the appropriation of pre-existing images, giving them new meanings and readings.

*Cipriano Martínez* is an abstract painter whose inspiration comes from the urban landscape and its constant change.

*Lucia Pizzani's* work concerns gender and its representation in art, be it through photography, sculpture or performance.

*Piers Veness* is interested in line and colour, creating bold architectural-organic forms in his paintings.

The starting point for *Augusto Villalba's* work is often photographs, either his own or from the media, which he translates into abstract paintings.

*Simon Zabell's* work is about creating narratives through painting, recreating scenes or atmospheres from literature and music.
