## 8 Egerton Garden Mews Group Exhibition

Square Art Projects is pleased to announce its first pop-up exhibition after relocating to London, showcasing work from six international artists working in photography, painting and sculpture.

The artists on show are: *Katherine Di Turi, Cipriano Martínez, Lucia Pizzani, Piers Veness, Augusto Villalba and Simon Zabell.* 

The exhibition will highlight the connections between the artists and their practices. Although these artists are from different countries and backgrounds, they are linked through their training in London: three of them studied at the Slade, and three of them studied at Chelsea.

The photographs of *Katherine Di Turi* are centered upon the appropriation of pre-existing images, giving them new meanings and readings.

*Cipriano Martínez* is an abstract painter whose inspiration comes from the urban landscape and its costant change.

Lucia Pizzani's work concerns gender and its representation in art, be it through photography, sculpture or performance.

*Piers Veness* is interested in line and colour, creating bold architectural-organic forms in his paintings.

The starting point for *Augusto Villalba's* work is often photographs, either his own or from the media, which he translates into abstract paintings.

Simon Zabell's work is about creating narratives through painting, recreating scenes or atmospheres from literature and music.
